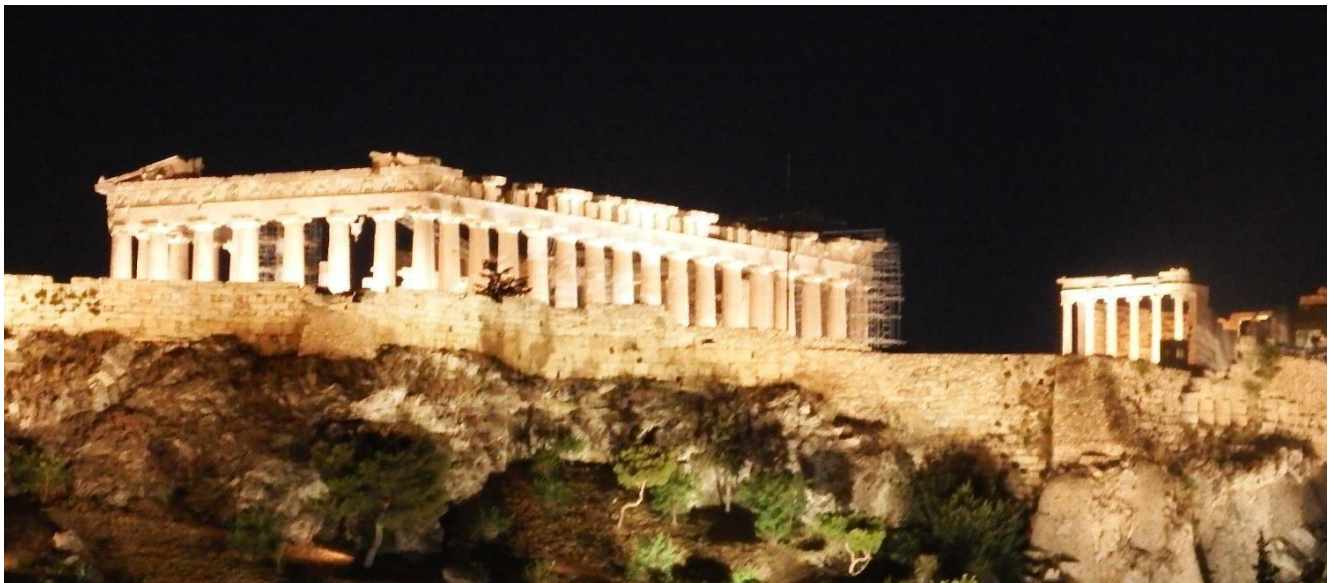

At last count, Greece had only 10 x 18-hole golf courses. This would normally suggest that Greece is far from a powerhouse of European golf however having played the top 5 Greek golf courses in October 2024, we can report that these 5 golf courses are up with the best in Europe. Furthermore, the Costa Navarino Golf Resort, with the top 4 golf courses in Greece, is arguably the number one golf resort in Europe and compares favorably with the best in the world. This is a standout golfing location, with the resort offering 4 x five-star hotels (Mandarin Oriental, W Hotel, Westin and Romanos) to tick all the boxes in terms of luxury accommodation, plentiful dining options, beaches and great service.

Greece is a beautiful country with a near ideal climate for golf. Its history and culture ensure it is a fascinating country to explore aside from golf. And of course, the typical Greek cuisine is a lively and fresh – think delicious lamb, plentiful olives and oils, superb salads with the best tomatoes, and regional cheeses. Our 2024 Greece experience was the prime reason for this proposed tour, one that you will undoubtedly love.

Our journey starts in Athens on 2 May 2026 with 2 nights at the 5-star **Athens Capital Hotel**, part of Accor's MGallery boutique hotel collection. Its location is central Athens, but a short walk to Syntagma Square and the Greece Parliament with its hourly changing of the guard. The Parthenon, a partially restored temple which stands on a hill and dominates the city of Athens, is less than a 2km walk. Many restaurants, including one at our hotel, offer a rooftop restaurant where night-time views of the resplendent Parthenon never fail to disappoint.



Our tour continues to Crete where we fly to Heraklion, the administrative capital of Crete and the 4th largest city in Greece. It is a 25 minute transfer to the **Crete Golf Club** and our home for the next 4 nights, the **Crete Golf Club Hotel**. The Crete Golf Club and Hotel sit on a hill with panoramic views of the surrounding countryside. This is the only 18 hole

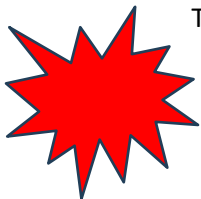
golf course in Crete and we will play it twice. What a course - one exciting hole after another with excellent course conditioning throughout. The hotel includes 26 rooms, all of a high standard and large at 45 sqm (including balcony), with stunning views of the golf course and surrounding area. There is a lovely lounge and balcony area, perfect for after-golf drinks and snacks. Apart from 2 golf games, our stay at the Crete Golf Club will include a day's guided tour of the island of Crete followed by an included lunch (and drinks). Also included is an evening out in Heraklion when we coach into the old town with included dinner and drinks at one of the leading local fish restaurants.

From Crete, we fly direct to Athens and then coach to the **Costa Navarino Golf Resort**. We will stay here 6 nights and play 4 golf games – one each at all four of the resorts outstanding golf courses. An option has been negotiated to stay an extra night and to play a 5th game of golf.



The golf courses are tremendous. All are impeccably maintained and conditioning, layouts and Aegean views easily rival golf courses such as Kauri Cliffs. We have been to many of the great and/or famous golf resorts throughout the world (e.g. Pebble Beach, Kiawah Island, Bandon Dunes and Gleneagles) and without doubt Costa Navarino is at worst equivalent but probably better than the best we have ever visited. Factor in the great weather at Costa Navarino, and a relatively favorable cost structure and it's a winner.

Our tour concludes after the Costa Navarino stay, from where we have included a transfer to either Kalamata (30 minutes) or Athens (3 ½ to 4 hours) for onward connection to your next destination.



Trendsetter Travel Golf Tours has scheduled a Tauck golf river cruise from Milan to Amsterdam to commence 2 days following (on 16 May 2026) the conclusion of your Greece Golf Tour (on 14 May 2026). Those booked on the Greece golf tour who join the Tauck river cruise will receive an AUD 250 pp contribution to your cost of transferring to Milan where the Tauck golf cruise commences.



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Saturday 2 May 2026

Arrive independently at Athens airport and transfer to **Athens Capital Hotel, an M Gallery Collection Hotel**, for a 2 night stay. You will stay in Deluxe King Bedded city view rooms with walk in showers. At 29 sqm, the rooms are large by Athens' standards and are two categories up from the lead in Classic Rooms. Extra nights pre tour are available at our group rate.

Tonight at **7.00 pm** we meet for welcome drinks and dinner on the roof top restaurant of our hotel with its views of the Parthenon.

We have negotiated an option where all our Greek tour guests can arrive 1 x day early (on 1 May 2026) and stay in the Athens Capital Hotel for a cost of an additional EUR 550 double (EUR 525 single). This rate includes breakfast and all taxes other than the recently introduced EUR 15/room night environmental levy. Additional nights prior to 1 May 2026 are subject to availability and do not have the guaranteed room rate.

Inclusions: Accommodation, pre dinner drinks and dinner (including drinks over dinner)



Sunday 3 May 2026 – Athens – Free Day

Today is a free day to independently explore Athens. The Parthenon dominates Athens from its elevated position on a hill. This is a must see visit and a mere 20 minute walk to the ticket office and a further 10 minute walk up the hill to the Parthenon. While you can taxi around Athens, it is an easy city to explore by foot with so much to see and history to experience. Adjacent to our hotel is the historic Grand Bretagne Hotel, headquarters for the occupying British and German forces in WWII. We recommend you visit the hotel for a drink in its historic bar or perhaps dine at the hotel's roof top restaurant, renowned for its stunning evening views of the Parthenon. Wherever you dine, reservations are recommended for notable restaurants with roof top views of the Parthenon.



Inclusions: Accommodation and breakfast

Monday 4 May 2026 – Athens – Flight to Crete - Crete

We all have most of the morning free in Athens before we board an 11 am coach transfer to Athens Airport to catch the Aegean Airlines flight 314 (1.25 pm/2.20 pm) to Heraklion in Crete. On arrival, we have a 25 minute transfer to **Crete Golf Club and Hotel**.

This evening you can rest up and dine inside, or outside on the large deck with views of the 18th green. We dined there in October 2024 and the restaurant was tremendous, reasonably priced with a spectacular ambience.

Inclusions: Accommodation and breakfast, airport transfers and flight to Crete

Tuesday 5 May 2026 – Crete – Golf – Game 1

Enjoy an expansive buffet breakfast before our first round of two games at the **Crete Golf Club**. The golf club is the only 18-hole golf club on Crete and it is a great experience to play. It is not a long course and the straight hitters will certainly score well. Remember to take your camera for beautiful pictures of stunning golf hole after golf hole as you wind around the valleys and hills surrounding the hotel. We tee off for golf at 10 am. The pro shop is located underneath the hotel's reception and after picking up your motorised cart, it is only a short drive to the 1st tee. We have booked sufficient motorised carts on both days for all our group. A two tee start is possible.



This evening, we will coach to Heraklion and dine at one of the leading local fish restaurants (expected to be **Saradari** – <https://www.saradari.com/en/>) facing the waterfront with great sea and sunset views. There will be time to walk around the Old Town before we dine.

Inclusions: Accommodation, breakfast, golf, dinner including drinks

Wednesday 6 May 2026 – Crete – Tour of Island

After breakfast, we leave at 9 am for a tour of this beautiful and mountainous island including a late lunch in Heraklion and time to wander around this historic town. The town was successfully defended by Australian troops in May 1941 against the German paratroop/glider invasion. When the key western part of the island was lost to the Germans, the 2 x Australian battalions were disembarked at night by sea back to the port of Alexandria in Egypt.

Inclusions: Accommodation, breakfast, tour of Crete and lunch including drinks

Thursday 7 May 2026 – Crete – Golf – Game 2

Mid-morning, we will play our second game at the Crete Golf Club. Apart from our daily competitions, you will also be playing for the Trendsetter Travel Crete trophy (played over 36 holes – with ladies, mens and 2BBB competitions). Independent dining tonight at the Crete Golf Club when the 36 hole winners will be announced. We tee off for golf at 10 am, all our group with motorised carts.

Inclusions: Accommodation, breakfast and golf

Friday 8 May 2026 – Fly to Costa Navarino

After breakfast, we transfer to Heraklion Airport for our 9.35 am flight to Athens (Aegean Airlines 305) and our 6 night minimum stay at **Costa Navarino** <https://www.costanavarino.com> . We will have a magnificent circa 4 hour drive from Athens to Costa Navarino through the mountain valleys of the Peloponnese Region, including a crossing of the Corinth Canal (with a chance to stop and take photographs). We should arrive at Costa Navarino a little after 3.30 pm in the afternoon.



On arrival at Costa Navarino, we have a slight change of plans. We had booked all our minimum 6 x nights at the beachside **W Hotel** where we will be allocated either a **Wonderful Bay Guest Room Partial Sea View** Or **Spectacular Panorama Guest Room Sea View** room, each with its own private balcony – refer link - <https://www.costanavarino.com/w-costa-navarino-accommodation-2/> Your room will be 40 sqm with a walk in shower and views of the Aegean Sea. The W Hotel enjoys convenient access to the four courses.

However, the W Hotel subsequently sold out the entire hotel to a group for the night of 8/9 May 2026 notwithstanding our booking. We have negotiated that we will stay 1 x night in equivalent rooms at the Romanos Luxury Hotel for the night of 8/9 May and when we are at golf on the morning of 9 May, all our luggage will be moved to our rooms at the W Hotel. This should be a seamless move.

The **Wonderful Bay Guest Room Partial Sea View** and the **Spectacular Panorama Guest Room Sea View** rooms are physically identical. The only difference is the view. The Spectacular Panorama rooms are a minimum one level higher than the Wonderful Bay rooms and can see a greater amount of sea above the hotel rooms in front. However, the Wonderful Bay Guest rooms still have a good view. The option exists to ensure you are allocated a Spectacular Panorama room by paying an additional EUR 85 per room night.

The Costa Navarino Resort itself has 18 restaurants allowing a wide range of dining options. You can download the local app and make bookings in a convenient manner. The remainder of today is free for you to independently explore the resort and its offerings.

There are 3 sets of clubrooms with the Hills and Olympic courses sharing common club rooms. After golf, the bars and lounges of all 3 clubrooms provide wonderful service and stunning views of the respective golf courses and surrounding landscapes. After each round (other than the final round), Costa Navarino will either store your clubs or transfer them to the next course, per our golf schedule.



Our package at Costa Navarino includes accommodation, breakfast and 4 games of golf per person, one at each of the 4 golf courses. Our 1st tee times vary each day between 9.10 am and 10.20 am. Tee times are one tee and at 10-minute intervals with all players utilising motorised carts. However, given our tee times will be spread over approaching 90 minutes, we will travel from hotel to the various golf courses on a staggered basis to avoid any unnecessary waiting around.

Inclusions: breakfast, flight, transfer and accommodation

Saturday 9 May 2026 – Costa Navarino – Golf Game 3 – Hills Golf Club

After a relaxing breakfast, transfer to your first golf game at the **Hills Golf Club** (tee off from 10 am). The Hills course is at times routed near the coastline and has stunning views. This rivals the Bay Course as our favourite of the four golf courses.

Alongside the two courses, is the stunning Hills Clubhouse, which serves both the Hills and Olympic golf courses.



After your golf game and group drinks (lunch is optional and at your personal cost), you will be transferred back to the W Hotel to be relocated into your new hotel room.

Sunday 10 May 2026 – Costa Navarino – Golf Game 4 – Dunes Course

The Dunes Course, the first signature-designed golf course in Greece, opened in May 2010. It was designed by two-time US Masters Champion and former Ryder Cup Captain Bernhard Langer in association with European Golf Design. This championship course, set in a diverse natural landscape, offers spectacular sea and river views and incorporates some links-style features in areas closest to the sea. Parts of the course venture into olive and fruit groves, while some holes run along a small river – the Sellas – which meanders through the site. Combined with large undulating greens, wide fairways and steep-faced pot bunkers, the links element of the course adds to its unique style and playability.

Our group has a tee off on the Dunes course today from 10.20 am

Inclusions: Accommodation, breakfast and golf



Monday 11 May 2026 – Costa Navarino – Free Day

Today give your body a rest from golf to enjoy all that Costa Navarino has to offer. Perhaps some water sports or simply relaxing by the pool or beachside. Explore the small shopping centre adjacent to the W Hotel, or spend some time in the spa. Those who love a stroll can walk a couple of kilometres along the beach to an authentic Greek village where the tavernas serve the freshest of fish.

Inclusions: Accommodation and breakfast

Tuesday 12 May 2026 – Costa Navarino – Golf Game 5 – Bay Course



The 18-hole, Par 71 seaside **Bay Course** at Navarino Bay, designed by Robert Trent Jones II, provides both a fun experience and a challenging test for golfers of all levels. Just a few minutes from the Dunes Course, the Bay Course offers an alternative set of challenges and choices in a quite different setting. With most tees offering sublime sea views and two holes playing along the historic Bay of Navarino, this will be the favourite course for many. The course is a little shorter than the Dunes Course and meanders through three distinct natural landscapes. Our group has tee off from 9.30 am.

Inclusions: Accommodation, breakfast and golf

Wednesday 13 May 2026 – Costa Navarino – Golf Game 6 – Olympic Course

Today, we play the 4th of Costa Navarino's four golf courses, the **Olympic Course**. Probably the hardest of the four golf courses, it weaves through the hills and presents a challenge to play close to your handicap. Our golf group has tee off from 9.10 am.

Tonight, we will have our final tour drinks and dinner (including drinks) at one of the many restaurants at the resort.

Inclusions: Accommodation, breakfast, golf and farewell drinks and dinner

Thursday 14 May 2026 – Costa Navarino – Tour Ends

Following breakfast, your Greek tour comes to an end. Subject to availability, you can stay extra nights post tour at Costa Navarino at our special group rate – these are available on request and our rate varies dependent if you wish to include golf in your room rate. Golf at Costa Navarino is always heavily booked and reservations for extra games will need to be made as early as possible for the best chance to play at preferred times or indeed any time.

A departure transfer to either Athens, Athens Airport or Kalamata Airport is included irrespective of departure date from Costa Navarino.

Inclusions: Accommodation, breakfast and transfer to airport of your choice.

However, with many of us likely to want to stay an extra night we have negotiated for all our group the option to stay an extra night at Costa Navarino (particularly those who have committed to the Milan to Amsterdam golf cruise commencing in Milan on 16 May) and to also play golf on the Hills course (blocked times from either 8.30 am or 12.10 pm). The cost of the extra night (including taxes and breakfast but not the EUR 15/room night environmental levy) is EUR 280/room for a double/twin and EUR 255 for a single. Golf costs an extra EUR 190 pp (including shared golf cart). On 14 May, times are not available on the other 3 x golf courses – two of which are sold out for the day for tournaments. Note optional golf on 15 May does not include drinks or prize money post golf. Also, the cost of accommodation does not include the EUR 15/room night Climate Change Levy.

For those travelling to Milan on the 4.50 pm flight on 15 May we will organize a coach transfer from Costa Navarino at 10 am that morning (the transfer is included as part of your tour cost).

The Finer Details ...

1. Inclusions

- Meals as specified to include breakfast daily and selected lunches and dinners. Apart from the welcome/farewell dinners and a night out in Heraklion, we have left you free to enjoy dinner as you please. Athens and Costa Navarino offer plentiful dining experiences for you to enjoy;
 - Golf as specified with green fees and all with carts – this includes drinks and prize money post golf (other than for optional golf on 14 May);
 - Coach transfers as a group to and from golf courses and to airports;
 - 1 day of touring of Crete and a free day in Costa Navarino.
2. The full cost of the golf tour is **EUR 6,600 pp** (golfer) on a twin share basis (**EUR 13,200 per couple/pair**). A pricing adjustment of **EUR 1,700 pp** is provided for any non-golfers reducing the cost to **EUR 4,900 pp** for a non golfer on a twin share basis with a golfer. The price for a single golfer guest is **EUR 8,500**.
 3. A non-refundable deposit of **AUD 3,000 pp (AUD 6,000 per couple/pair)** is required at time of booking. If for whatever reason you need to cancel from the tour, we will refund 80% of your deposit payment subject to a replacement guest being found for the tour to take your place. For singles, the deposit is **AUD 5,000**.
 - The non-refundable total cost of the tour will be due in full by **31 December 2025**. The total tour cost will be calculated in AUD at the prevailing AUD/EUR exchange rate on or about **23 December 2025** with Trendsetter Travel Golf Tours using a more favorable rate than the best rate quoted by any of the big four Australian trading banks. The net amount payable in AUD is this sum less the AUD deposit paid.

Alternatively, we can process your credit card manually in our Sydney office. Whether using Travelpay or paying us using your credit card, all payments are subject to a recovery of merchant fee charges of approximately 1% for Visa/Mastercard and 2% for AMEX.

5. Comprehensive travel insurance is required – and is recommended at the time of deposit to fully protect your payments in the unfortunate event of cancellation. Please ensure coverage for any pre-existing illnesses.
6. Accommodation has been booked for all 12 nights of the tour (plus an additional optional night pre tour in Athens and post tour in Costa Navarino) and tee times have been booked for all 6 golf games (plus optional game on 14 May).
7. We have negotiated the right for you to arrive earlier than 2 May 2026 (as we assume most guests will so choose) to stay additional nights at the **Athens Capital Hotel** at our agreed group room rate of EUR 550 per night (including breakfast and taxes) plus an environmental levy of EUR 15 per room night (total EUR 565/night). Single occupancy rooms will be EUR 525 per room night plus environmental levy (total of EUR 540/night).
8. You can stay extra nights post tour (inclusive of breakfast and VAT) at Costa Navarino at our group rate of **EUR 290/room (twin share)** and **EUR 265/room (single)** and golf costs **EUR 190 pp** (inclusive of VAT and shared motorised cart) – we have these rooms under option with a requirement to settle payment at the time of your final payment in late December 2025. Our recent experience is that golf at Costa Navarino is booked out many months in advance. 14 May is no exception and we cannot block tee times on 3 of the 4 x golf courses with only the Hills Course available. We have booked 2 x blocks of tee times from 8.30 am and 12.10 pm. Booking tee times on 14 May other than what we have booked (with an option over) is unlikely to be a successful strategy.
9. Since 1 January 2025 there has been a substantially increased tourist tax (called Climate Change Resilience Levy) in Greece which is applied to tourists upon check out of a hotel. The hotel collects the tax and passes to the government. The tax is structured such that it does not add to the advertised room rates hotels quote (but of course it effectively increases the room rate). This tourist tax is now EUR 15 per room night for 5 star hotels over the period April to October (the rate is EUR 10 per room night for 4 star hotels). This is a tax we cannot

pay in advance of a group stay. In contrast, VAT is included in all hotel room rates and is captured in our group pricing. In summary, the Climate Change Resilience Tax/Levy will be payable by you personally on check out of each hotel and is not included in our quoted pricing in this tour itinerary.

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
